Cost

The state associaton’s journalism workshop has been designed to provide an optimum experience at a reasonable price, \$230 per student for 4 activity-packed days. The workshop fee includes most meals and air-conditioned door accommodations.

Format

The IHSPA workshop does not focus on basic reporting, photography, and computer design. The experience will begin with people skills: working with diverse personalities, fostering a team atmosphere, working as a partner with the adviser, and conflict management. Then, they move to teaching / leadership skills every editor should know. Finally, your editors practice their team skills. In one day, groups of four students will pull together an entire story package while relying on each other to perform specific duties.

Advisers will meet in separate sections. Workshop topics will move each adviser group from basic staff organization to distribution ideas and everything in-between.
